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

## **ASAM Criteria Subdimensions**

### Dimension 1: Intoxication, Withdrawal, and Addiction Medications

- Intoxication and Associated Risks
- Withdrawal and Associated Risks
- Addiction Medication Needs

#### **Dimension 2: Biomedical Conditions**

- Physical Health Concerns
- Pregnancy-Related Concerns
- Sleep Problems

#### Dimension 3: Psychiatric and Cognitive Conditions

- Active Psychiatric Symptoms
- Persistent Disability
- Cognitive Functioning
- Trauma-Related Needs
- Psychiatric and Cognitive History

#### Dimension 4: Substance Use-Related Risks

- Likelihood of Engaging in Risky Substance Us<sup>3</sup>
- Likelihood of Engaging in Risky SUD-Related Behaviors<sup>4</sup>

#### **Dimension 5: Recovery Environment Interactions**

- Ability to Function Effectively in Current Environment
- Safety in Current Environment
- Support in Current Environment
- Cultural Perceptions of Substance Use and Addiction

#### **Dimension 6: Person-Centered Considerations**

- Barriers to Care
- Patient Preferences
- Need for Motivational Enhancement
