

Many, many co-located services & resources


◆ ED stabilization (withdrawal, psychosis, suicidality, intoxication, overdose)

 Immediate bup access, wound care, financial counseling / insurance, interpreters for most languages, social services, hiv & hep c screening, STI screening & treatment, discounted medications, <u>SUNs</u>,

 Direct linkage to bridge clinic, sobering center, shelter, primary care, behavioral health services, specialty care, reproductive health services, hiv & hep c treatment, legal support, syringe services; etc...
